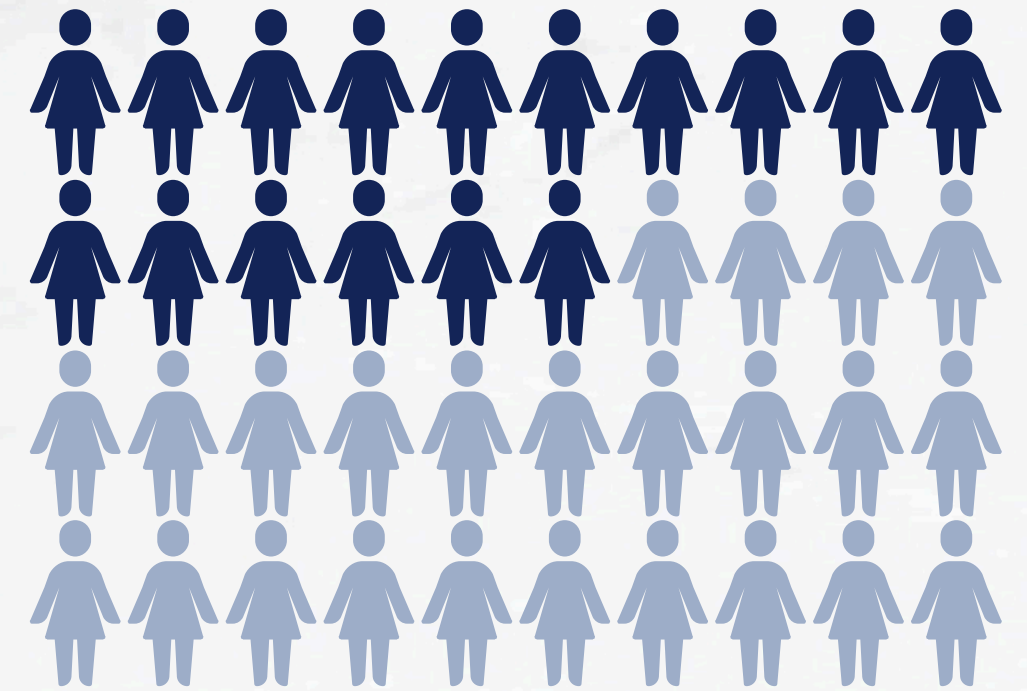

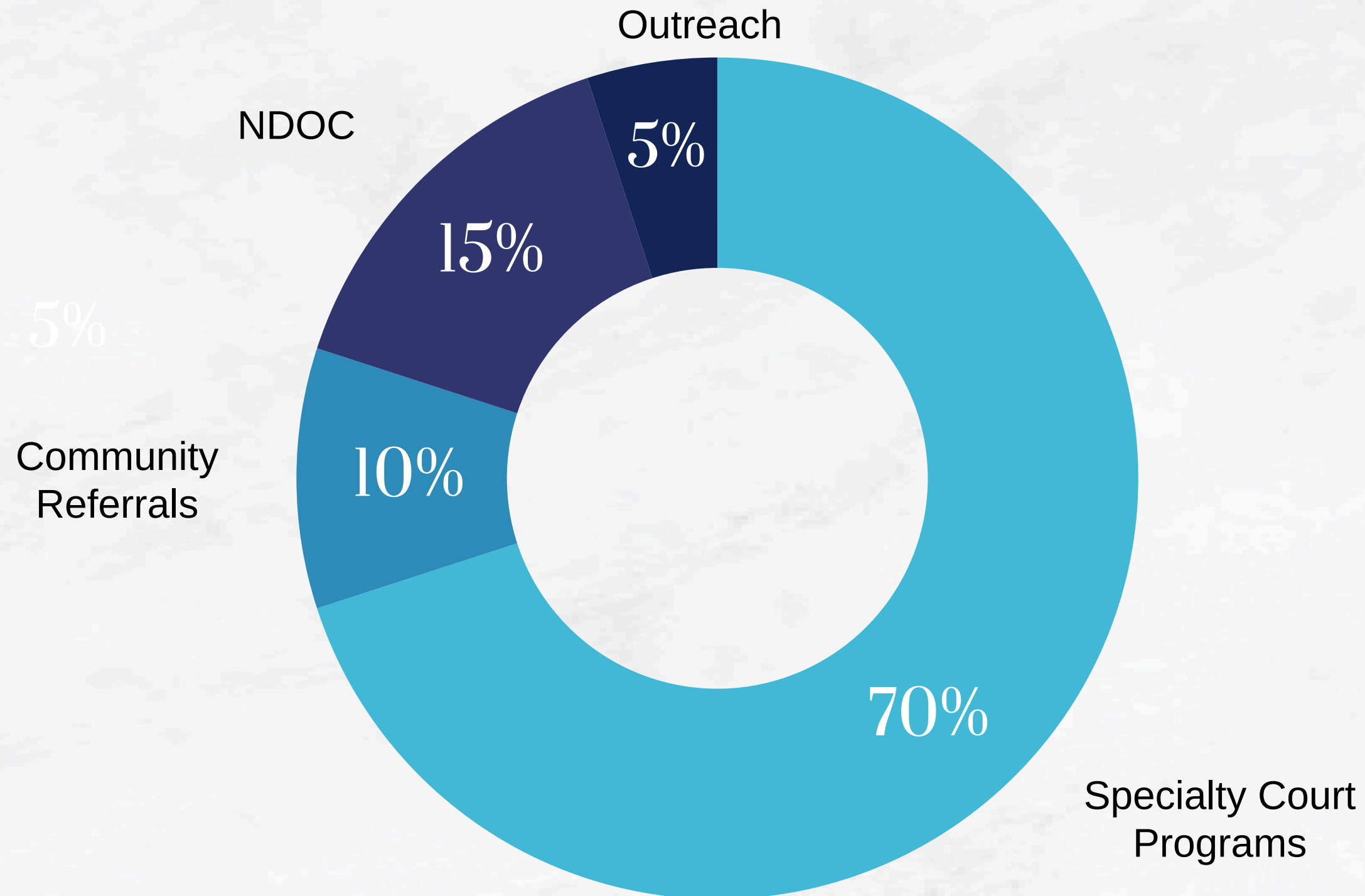

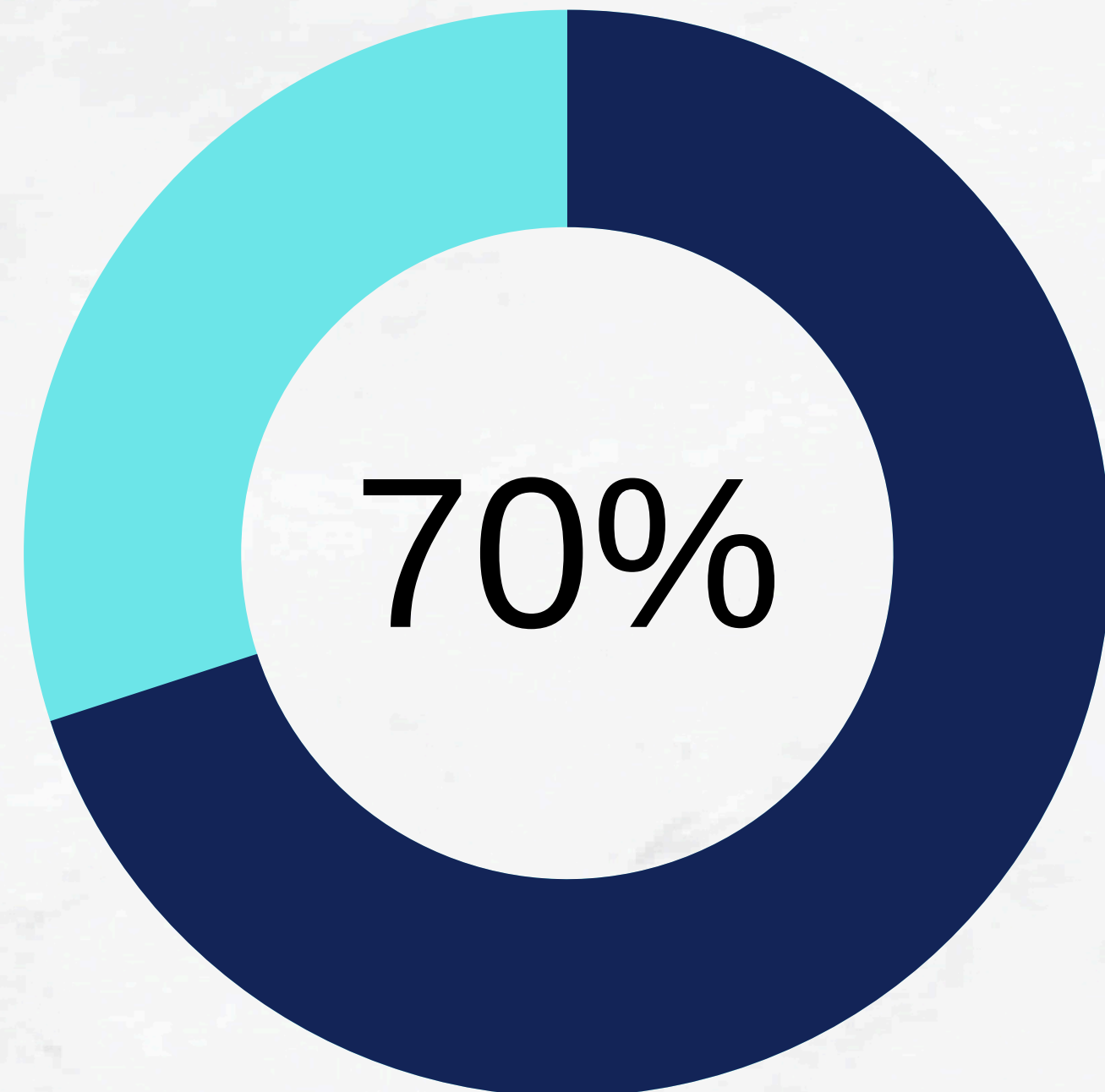

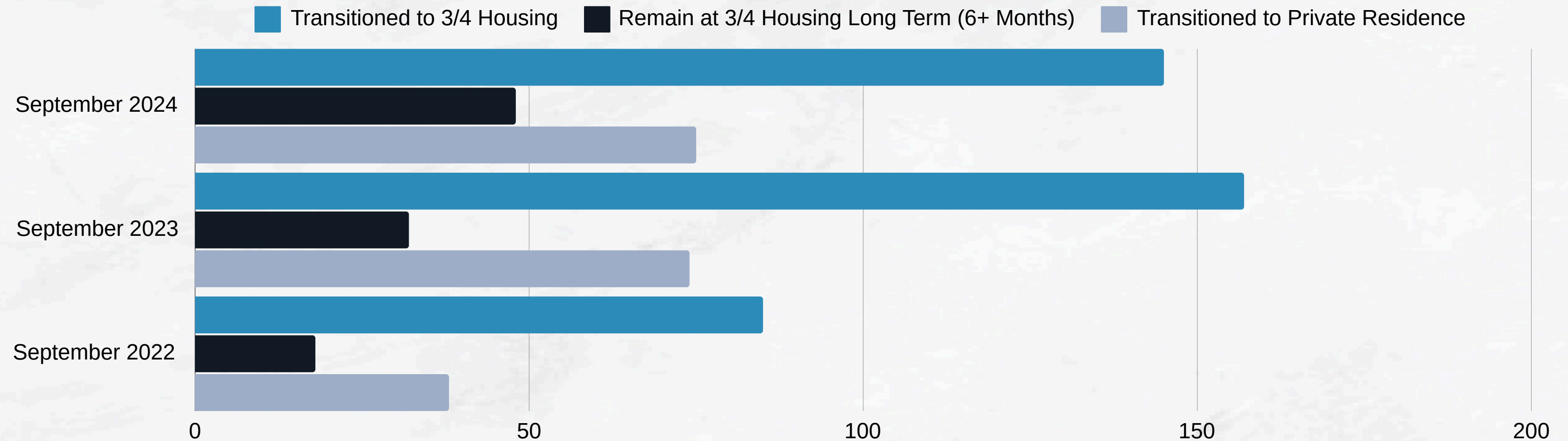

Successful Completions and Transitioned to 3/4 and Permanent Housing

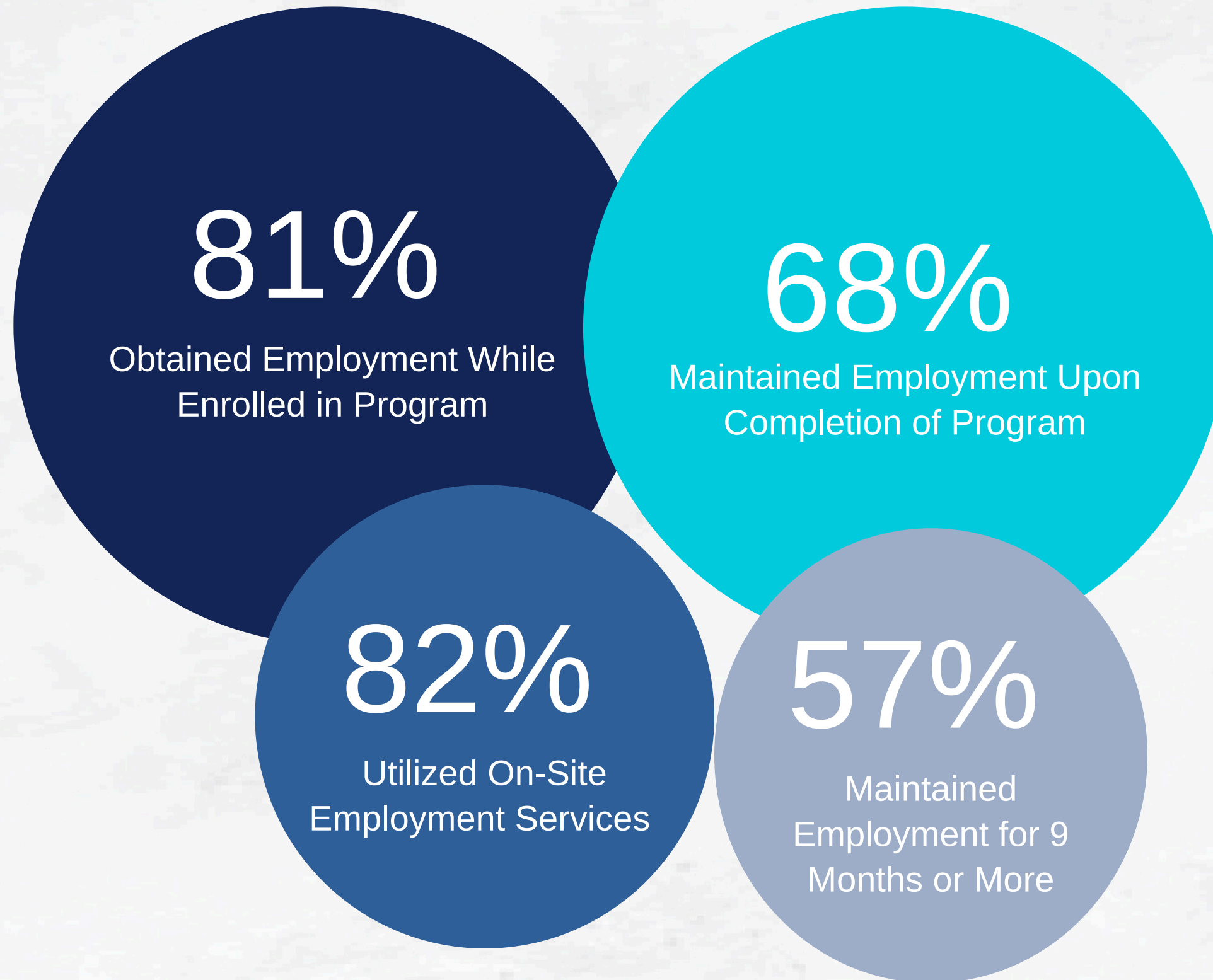

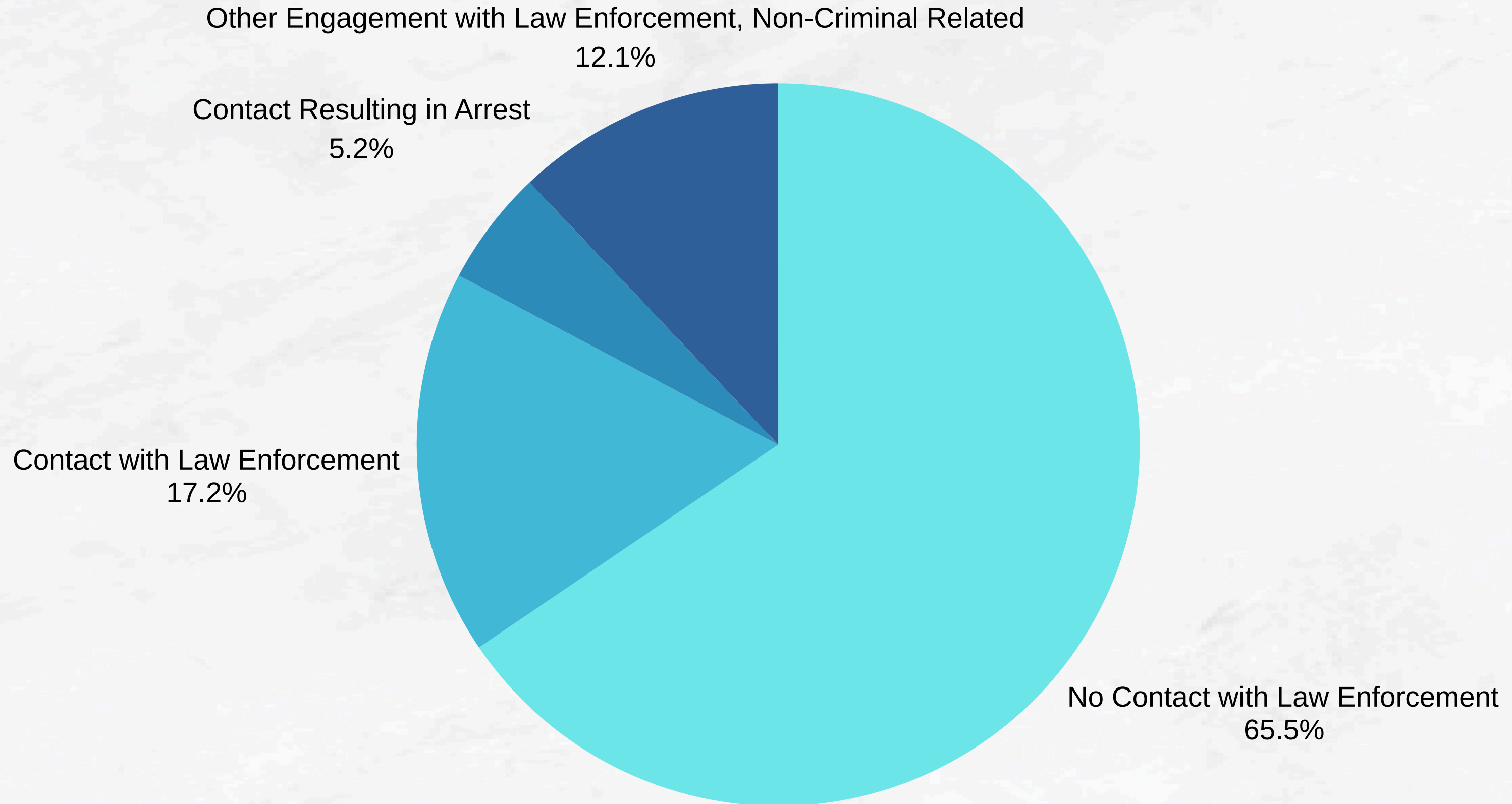
